

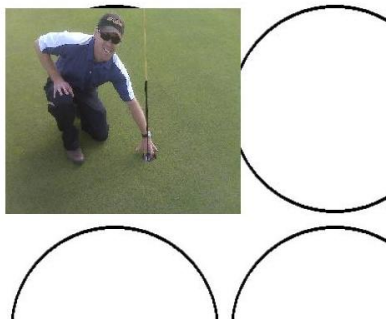

Basic instructions for circles

The easiest way to use circle icing sheet is to resize and position the pictures on a .jpg template. See below for basic instructions;

- 1) Resize the picture you wish to print using any picture editing program (example; Microsoft Paint) to approx to approx 2.5" x 2.5" (for 2.5" circles) and save the picture in a convenient place
- 2) Open the picture you wish to print with Microsoft Paint
- 3) With the picture you wish to print open in Microsoft Paint – click "edit" and then "select all"
- 4) Now open the circle template with Microsoft Paint
 1. click "edit" and then "paste"
 2. Using your mouse, click and hold the picture then move the picture to cover the area of one circle and then repeat from as required (see example below)
- 5) When complete – click "file" and then "save as" in a convenient place
- 6) Now print the file using your Edible Ink Printer System.
